Strengthening the advocacy on agroecological women-led initiatives

We invite women farmers to participate in the project aimed at developing advocacy skills and creating a joint program for education and promotion of agroecology.

As part of the project, you will take part in:

- **2-hour introductory online training**, where we will discuss together the challenges and needs of farmers and women living in the rural areas (August '24),
- **4-hour online training** focus on how to develop advocacy skills, formulate common demands, speak out on important issues (September '24),
- **4-day training and integration meeting** (October 18-21st '24), during which you will meet other active women working for their local communities and promoting the values of agroecology.

Join us if:

- you are a farmer/ food producer and your agricultural/ business activity is based on the values of ecology and respect for nature,
- you are socially active in your town (e.g. you are a village head, a member of the Rural Women's Circle, you work in local government, you run a support group or other initiative for your neighbours),
- you feel that women in your region need support and motivation to change and decide for themselves,
- you see the potential in creating a community of women who support each other and share their experience.
